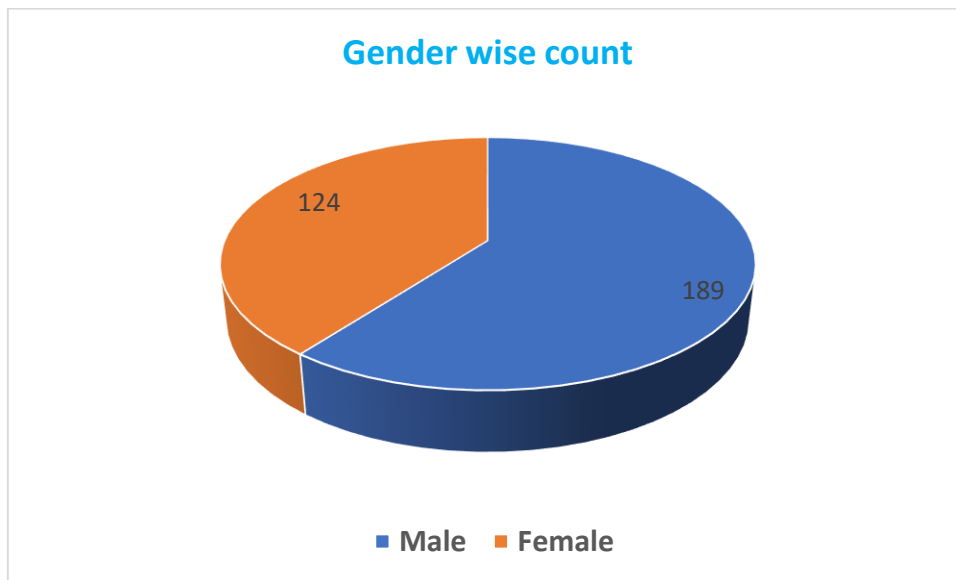


Figure-1: Gender wise data

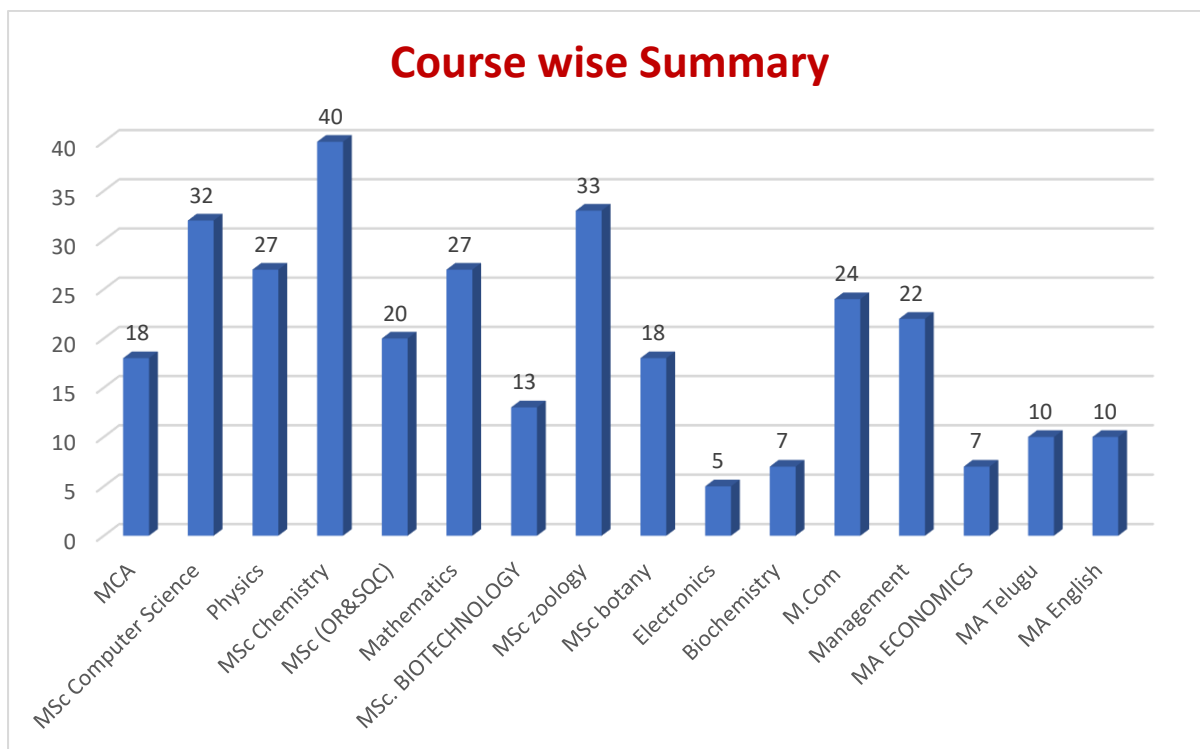


Figure-2: Course wise Summary

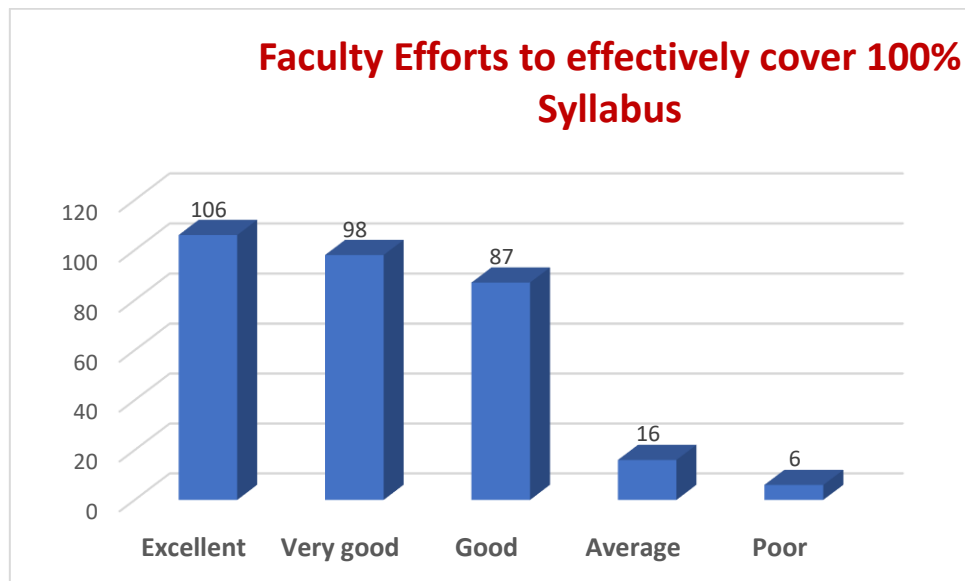


Figure-3: Faculty Efforts to effectively cover 100% Syllabus

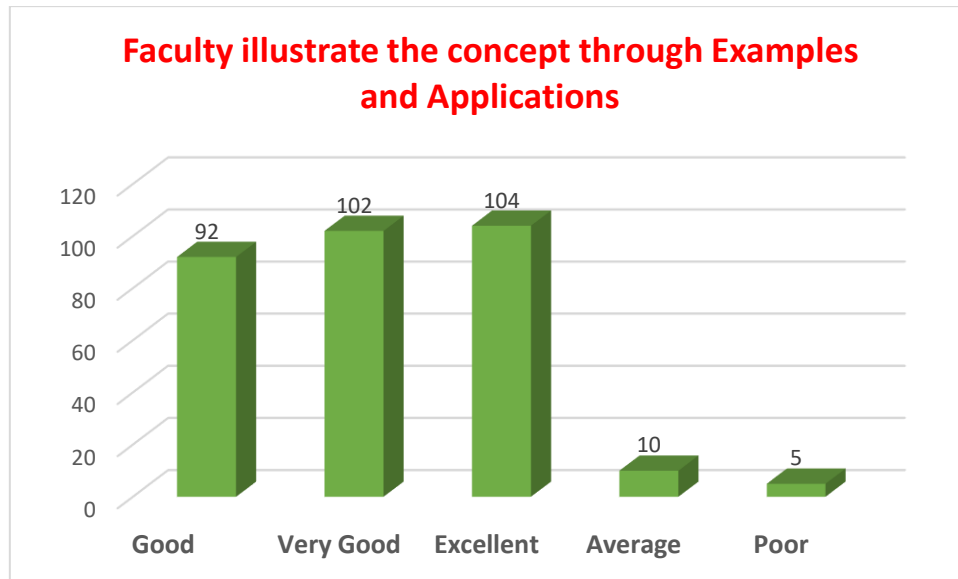


Figure-4: Faculty illustrate the concept through Examples and Applications

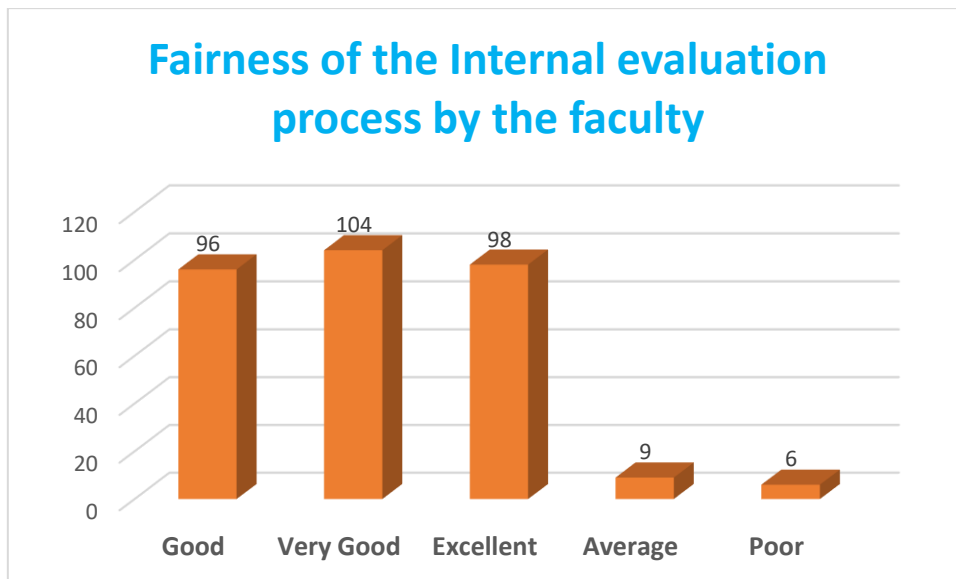


Figure-5: Fairness of the Internal evaluation process by the faculty

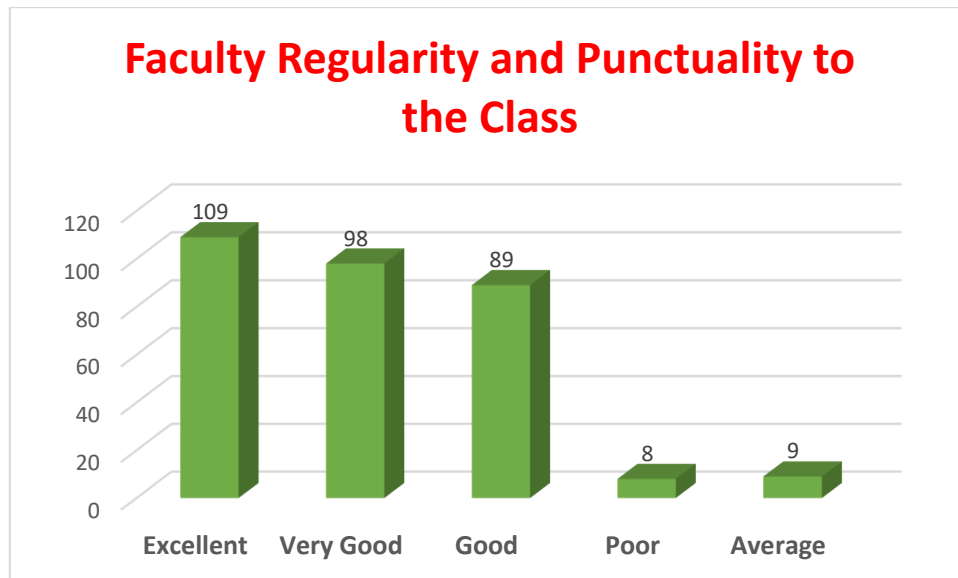


Figure-6: Faculty Regularity and Punctuality to the Class

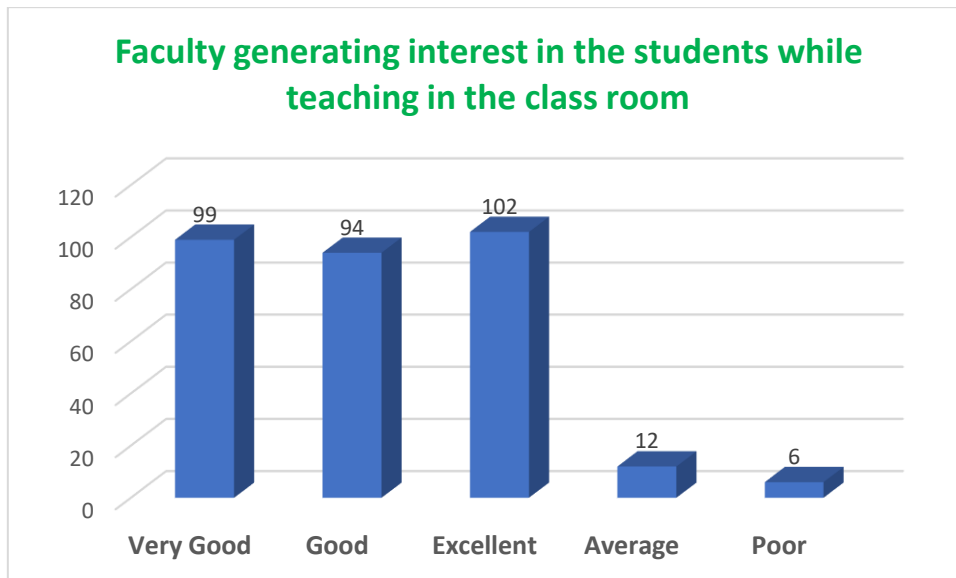


Figure-7: Faculty generating interest in the students while teaching in the class room

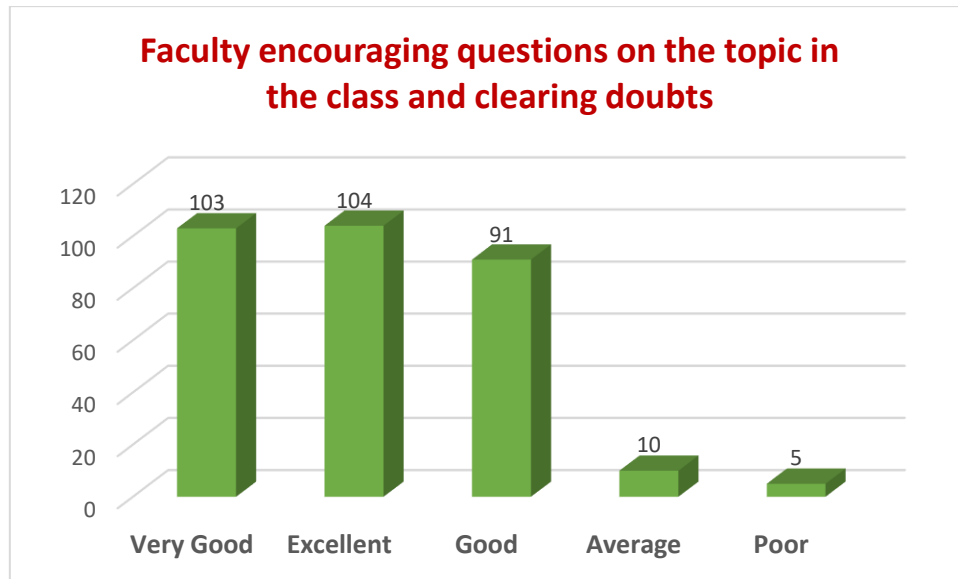


Figure-8: Faculty encouraging questions on the topic in the class and clearing doubts

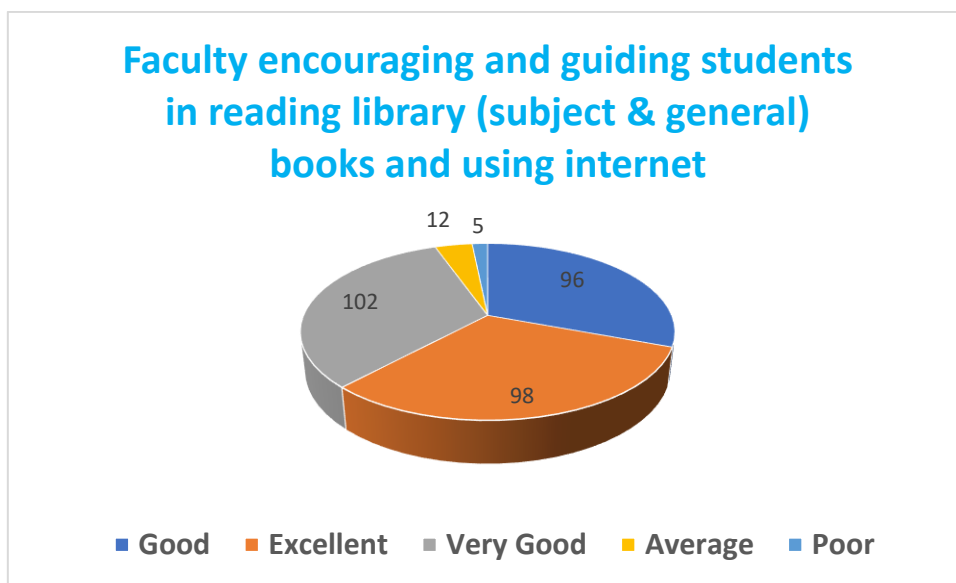


Figure-9: Faculty encouraging and guiding students in reading library (subject & general) books and using internet

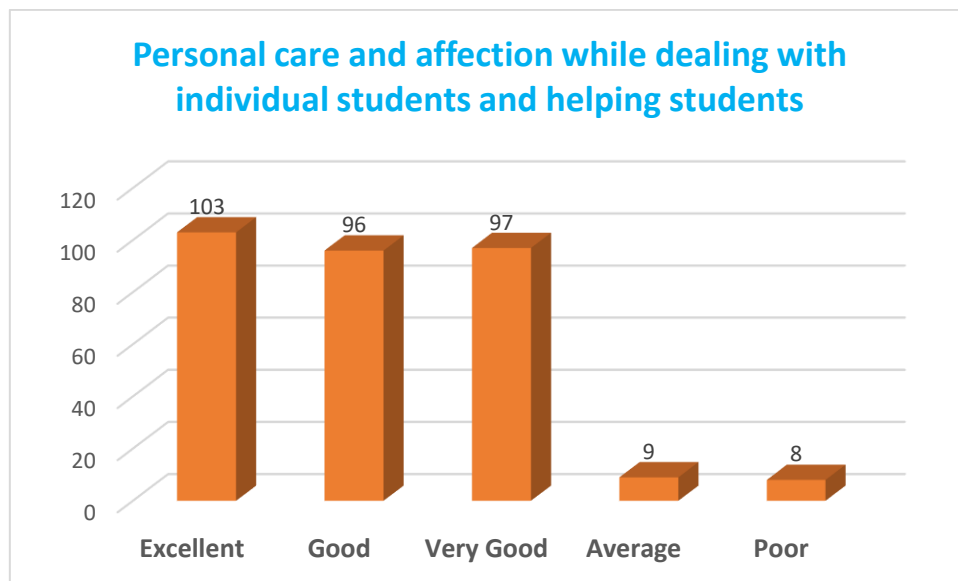


Figure-10: Personal care and affection while dealing with individual students and helping students

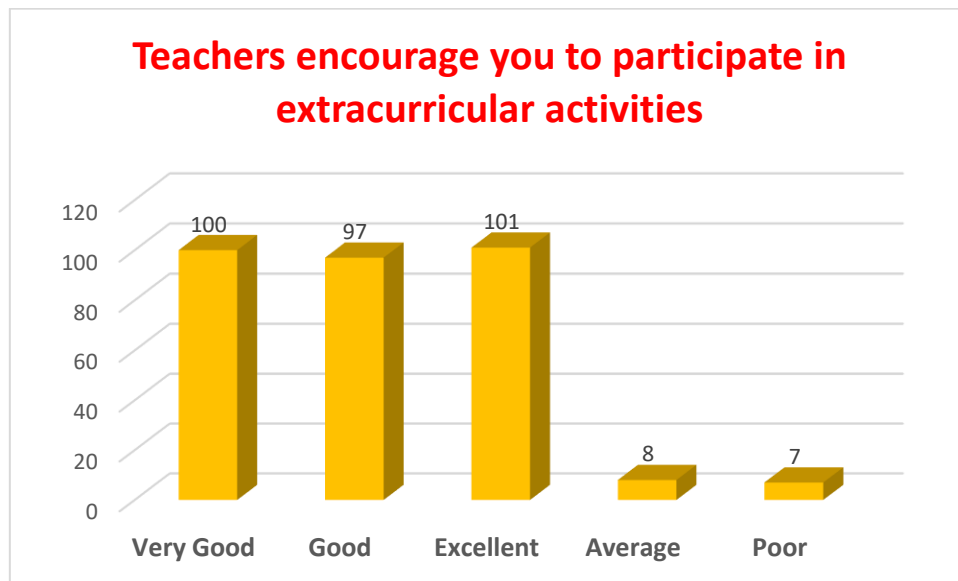


Figure-11: Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

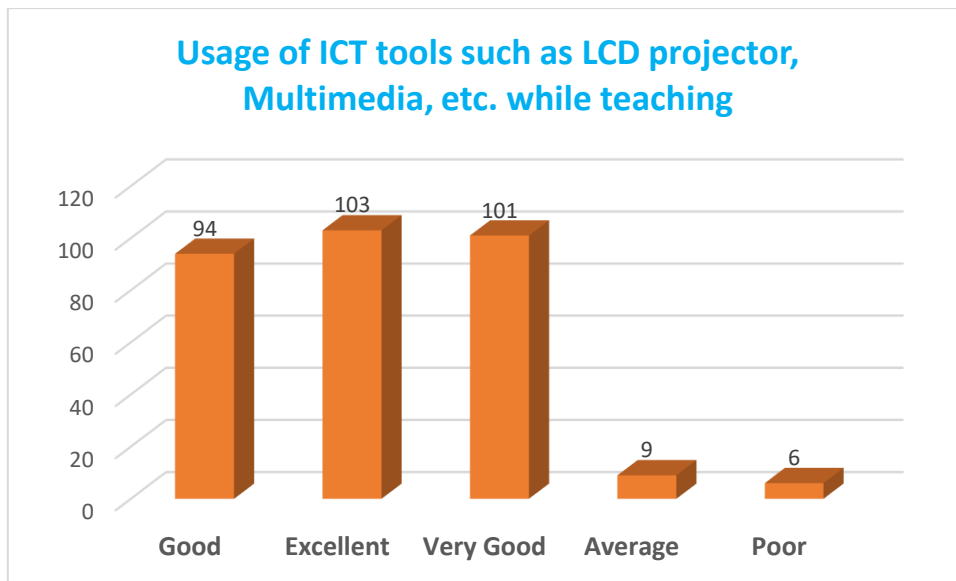


Figure-12: Usage of ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching

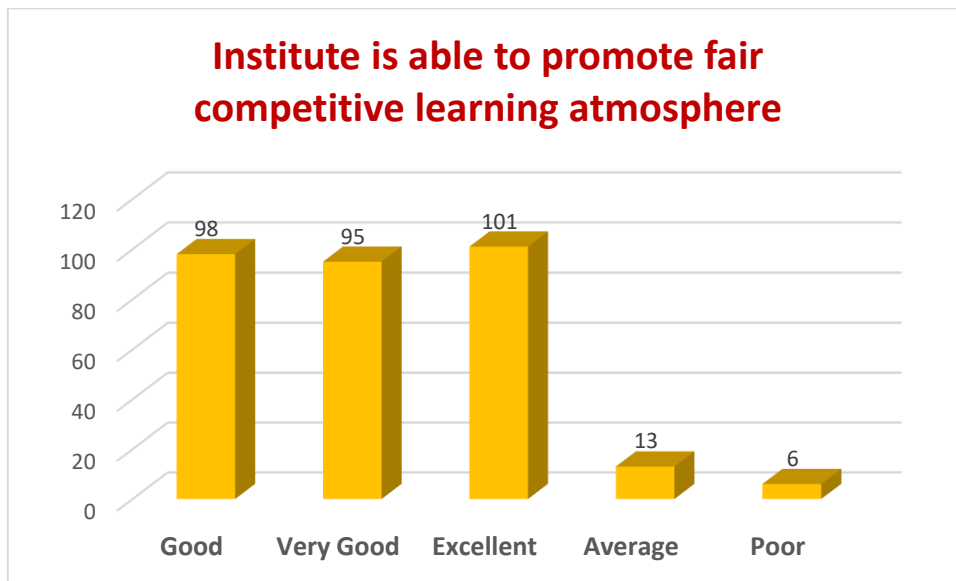


Figure-14: Institute is able to promote fair competitive learning atmosphere

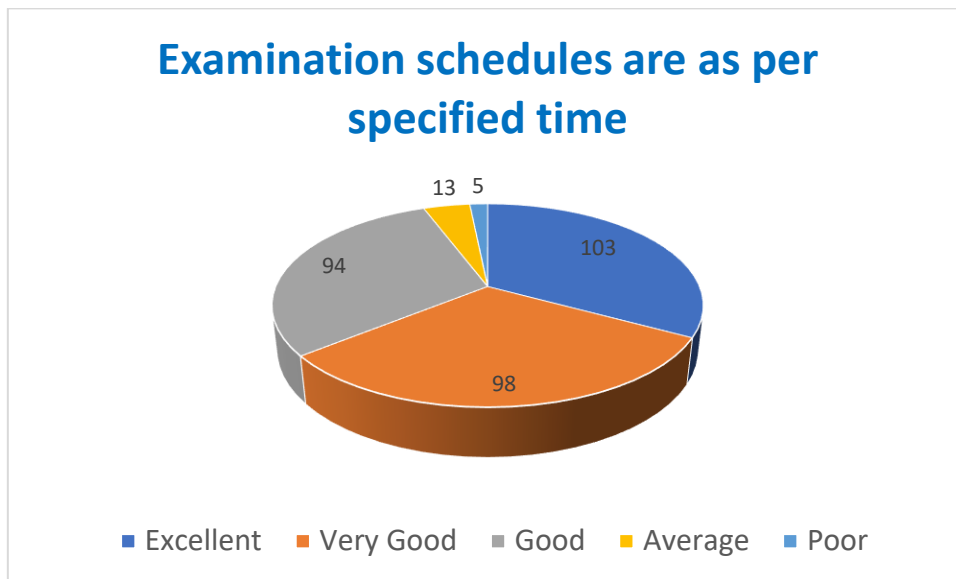


Figure-15: Examination schedules are as per specified time

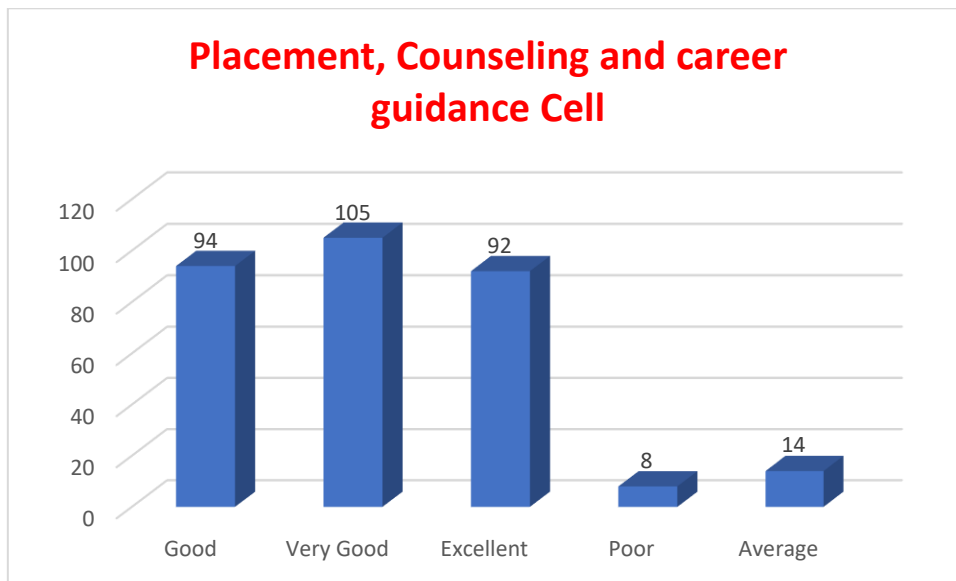


Figure-16: Placement, Counseling and career guidance Cell

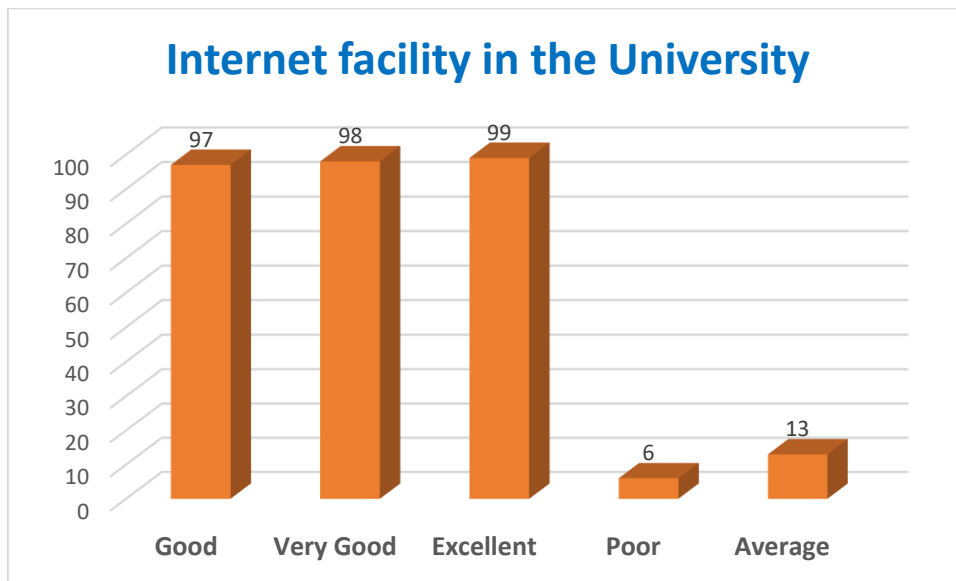


Figure-17: Internet facility in the University

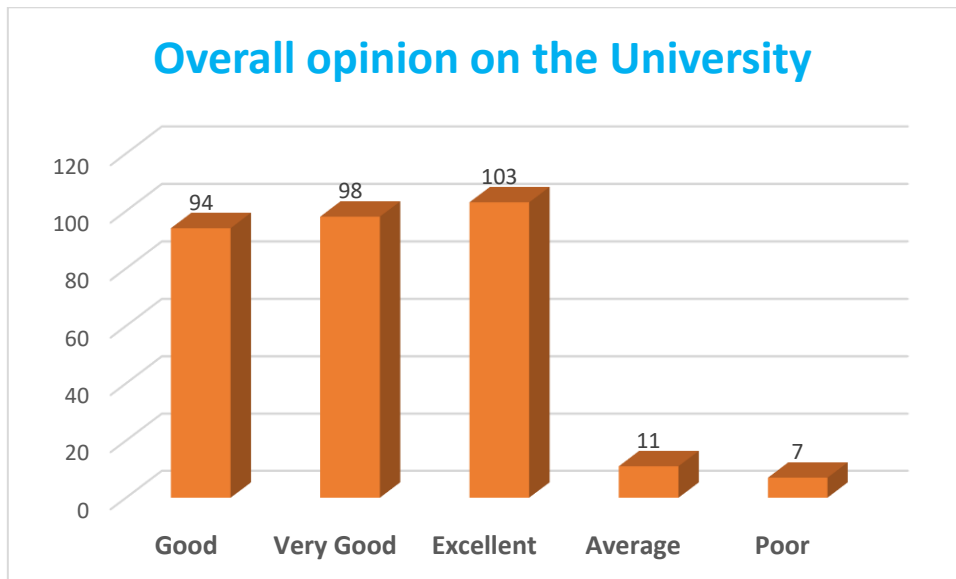


Figure-18: Overall opinion on the University
